

Analysis of Speed Indicator Device (SID) data for September & October 2024

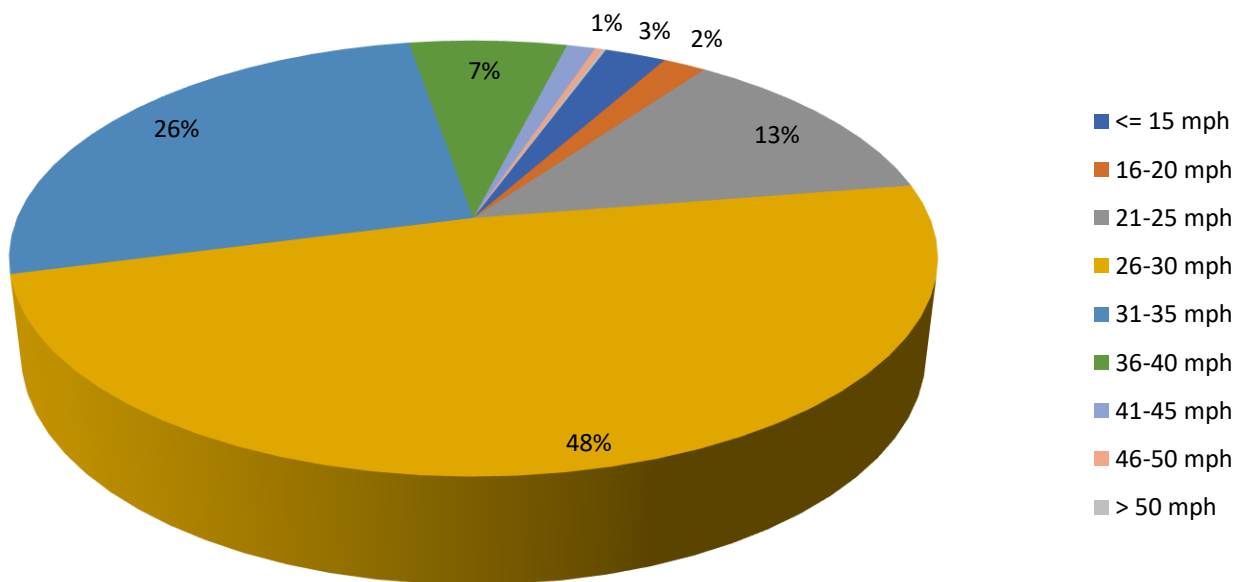
The SID was located on Bluntisham Road near the “Colne” sign, facing towards Bluntisham, for 45 days between September 1st & October 15th 2024. (The SID collects data not only from approaching vehicles but also from those departing in the opposite direction; in the case of departing vehicles the speed is not displayed to the driver.)

Over the 45 day period, one in three of all vehicles were recorded exceeding the 30 mph speed limit. The average speed was 29 mph with 15% of vehicles travelling at over 33 mph.

Vehicles approaching from Bluntisham

35% of vehicles were recorded as travelling in excess of the 30 mph limit with almost one in six (15%) recorded travelling at a speed greater than 34 mph. The average speed was 29 mph.

The diagram, below, shows the distribution of vehicle speeds arriving from Bluntisham:



Vehicles departing towards Bluntisham

(The speed of vehicles travelling in this direction is not displayed to the driver and so the presence of the SID is likely to be less of a deterrent.)

32.5% of all vehicles were travelling in excess of the 30 mph limit with almost one in six exceeding 33 mph. The average speed was 28 mph.
